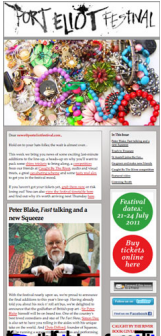

Website and e-marketing

Working closely with our friends at [Dewsign](#) (who built the Stranger website and worked on the iTunes festival sites with us) and [A-Side Studio](#) (Stranger magazine's art directors and long-time Stranger Collective collaborators), we helped plan the structure and content for the new Port Eliot Festival website (2009) and managed the build and propagation processes. We also led on the redesign of the website for 2011. Stranger Collective's copywriters write all the content for the website each year, including over 200 performer profile pages, and upload it all to the site - including pictures, videos and downloads.
